Conant’s Riverside Farm is a six generation farm and is one of the most recognized dairy farms in Vermont, with its popular sweet corn stand and landmark three-story red barn visible from a major highway. The farm stand, Deb explains, “brings people to the farm and helps people understand what it takes to make food.” The Conant’s are known innovators cover cropping their corn fields with helicopters and using a drag line to inject manure into the soil.

Isham Family Farm is a 5th generation farm which started as a dairy farm and has diversified into other areas. They are now known for their Christmas trees, berries, vegetables, maple sugaring, event barn and more.

Magic Hat Brewing Company has been putting a performance into every bottle of beer since 1994. Today, the South Burlington, VT based brewery puts out upwards of 175,000 barrels each year. Whether you prefer a pale ale or a dark beer, they have something for everyone.
